



Take a closer look at your monthly bill from Kentucky American Water—you might be surprised to learn that our water service charges are generally less than half of the total of the average customer's monthly bill.

This is an example of an average water bill and may be different than your bill.

■ **Current Water Charges** (the only portion of your payment that goes to Kentucky American Water) – This is the cost of your water service for the current billing period.

**Fees We Collect and Forward to Other Entities:**

- **LFUCG - Sewer Charges** – Your sanitary sewer bill paid to Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG). Using water wisely can help reduce your water service charge and this fee, too, since it is generally based on water usage.\*
- **LFUCG - Landfill Fee** – A Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government fee related to garbage collection that you may have included on your bill depending on where you live.\*
- **LFUCG - Wtr Qual Mgmt Fee** – Also known as the stormwater fee, a Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government (LFUCG) fee that goes toward the management of Lexington-Fayette County's storm sewer infrastructure.\*
- **KRA Withdrawal Fee** – This fee is collected for and forwarded to the Kentucky River Authority (KRA), a state agency that works to ensure that the Kentucky River remains a reliable source of water supply.
- **School Tax** – A fee that goes directly to support public education in Fayette County.
- **Franchise Fee - LFUCG** – A fee levied on public utility service providers. This is a direct "pass through" fee that goes to the LFUCG.

\*Kentucky American Water collects these fees for the LFUCG. This streamlined billing process benefits the LFUCG and our customers.

The next time you receive your monthly bill, take a closer look at everything it contains. And the next time you turn on your tap, flush a toilet, wash your clothes, run a dishwasher or water your lawn, think about all that goes into bringing water to your home, and the value of that water at less than a penny per gallon.
