## Live Green Lexington Program Overview

The Live Green Lexington Program is a joint program between Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government and Bluegrass PRIDE. Any Fayette County business or apartment complex is eligible to participate in this free program. This program helps organizations start or expand recycling programs, improve water quality and conservation, and become more energy efficient. Organizations may participate in all three programs or pick and choose the programs they wish to participate in. Contact Bluegrass PRIDE for more information.

- Personal visit and assistance on how to get the program started
- Help with assessing specific issues or needs on your property
- Waste audit, if requested
- Materials to promote recycling, such as posters, magnets and key chains
- Promotional materials available in both English and Spanish for your employees, residents, and/or staff
- Presentations for residents and employees on recycling/waste reduction, water improvement initiatives, and/or energy efficiency
